Concepts in Biotechnology Oxford University Press

Die aus vielfältigen Teilen und Objekten bestehende Publikation erscheint anlässlich der ersten institutionellen Ausstellung von Lucy McKenzie in Deutschland, zu der sie der Neue Aachener Kunstverein eingeladen hat. In Werk und Haltung repräsentiert Lucy McKenzie (geb. 1977 in Glasgow) eine Generation junger Kunst mit großem kunsthistorischen Bewusstsein. Sie setzt gezielte Verweise in die Vergangenheit und erinnert damit an Dekaden künstlerischer Karrieren in Schottland und England, an die Geschichte von Art and Crafts und sozialreformerischer Kunst, angewandte Gestaltung und "Mural Painting". In ihren bisherigen Produktionen sind vielzählige Referenzen angelegt, welche in Korrespondenz zu eigenen malerischen Arbeiten treten. Lucy McKenzie setzt eine Reflexion fort, die von Künstlerinnen und Künstlern der vorangegangenen Generation begonnen wurde und in ihrem Werk neue Facetten bzw. Erweiterungen erfährt. Hier geht es nicht mehr um Rezeptions- und Wirkungsgeschichte, sondern um künstlerische Intentionsgeschichte. Schwerpunkt sind weniger die bekannten Namen und Bewegungen, sondern vielfach abwegige, außenseiterische bzw. schwierige Positionen, die sich z.B. in explizit politischen, lokal agitatorischen oder soziokulturellen Haltungen begründen. Sie versetzt sich in die Motivationen und Funktionsbereiche ihrer Vorgänger und stellt hiermit letztlich entscheidende Fragen zur heutigen Bedeutung von künstlerischer Arbeit.

In response to the debate on the most adequate ethical doctrine to guide biomedical decisions, this book formulates views that capture the best elements in each, bearing in mind their differences and taking into account the specific character of medicine. No historically influential position in ethics is by itself adequate to be applied to reproductive decisions. Thus, this book attempts to offer a pluralistic approach to biomedical research and medical practice. One usually claims that there are some basic principles (non-maleficence, beneficence, confidentiality, autonomy, and justice) which constitute the foundations of bioethics and medical ethics. Yet these principles conflict with each other and one needs some criteria to solve these conflicts and to specify the scope of application of these principles. Exploring miscellaneous ethical approaches as introduced to biomedicine, particularly to reproductive genetics, the book shall elucidate their different assumptions concerning human nature and the relations between healthcare providers, recipients, and other affected parties (e.g. progeny, relatives, other patients, society). The book attempts to answer the question of whether the tension between these ethical doctrines generates conflict in the field of biomedicine or if these competing approaches could in some way complement each other. In this respect, lecturers and researchers in bioethics would be interested in this reading this book.

Preservation by fermentation is one of the oldest food technologies, and yet it continues to play an important role in meat preservation in many parts of the world. These processes can be relatively simple, with minimal microbial involvement, or more complex, involving defined ingredients and starter cultures with controlled environmental conditions. Most meat fermentations rely on the use of salt as an ingredient, sometimes with the addition of nitrate, nitrite and spices. In some cases the meat may be smoked and, as with some cheese fermentations, fermented meats may be ripened by moulds and yeasts. The preservation of meats by fermentation depends on the interaction of a number of environmental and microbiological factors including the pH, water activity, redox potential and the presence of preservatives and a competitive microflora. The subject of fermented meats is an important but relatively specialised area of microbiology and food technology. Few books have specifically addressed this subject and the topic has usually been dealt with in reviews and research papers with a significant proportion of these being published in languages other than English. As far as we are aware, this volume is the first to bring together a selection of key topics relating to the production of fermented meats and their chemical and microbiological properties. The book begins with a general chapter on the properties of meat.

The Pleasure Principle
